



Consortium achieves 250 000 injury-free work hours at Medupi

On Friday, LP Services Consortium received a bronze award from State-owned power utility Eskom for achieving 250 000 lost time injury (LTI) free manhours on site at the Medupi power plant project in Limpopo.

The consortium, led by Lesedi Nuclear Services, with Wetback Contacts and Industrial Water Cooling, were awarded the contracts for Medupi low-pressure services.

Eskom health and safety operations manager Andy Kirk said this achievement was unique to the consortium on both the Medupi and the Kusile coal-fired power plant projects.

The consortium also received a project award from Eskom for achieving 365 days without a LTI and several project employees were recognised for their contribution to safety.

Lesedi MD Francis Carruthers described it as a milestone safety achievement for the project team.

He added that the bar must be raised and the consortium aimed to achieve one-million LTI free manhours.
